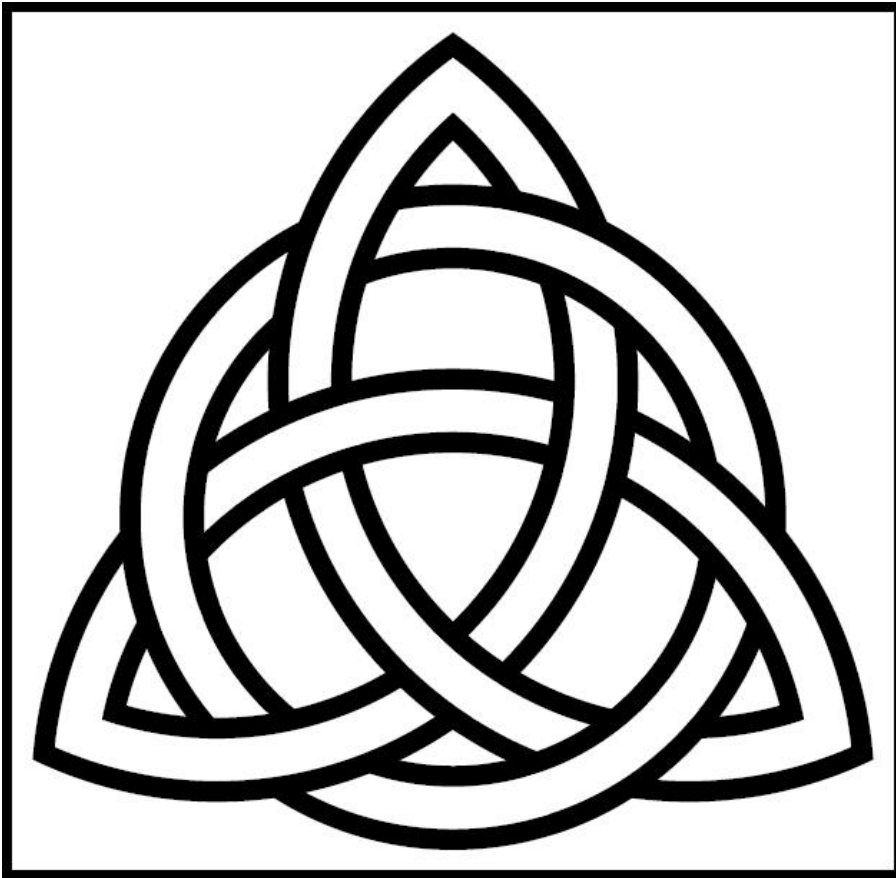

Bishop Young Jin Cho announced that the **2015 Annual Conference offering** goal will be \$150,000 to support three different ministries. The offering goal includes \$50,000 for continued support of our partnership with the Methodist Mission in Cambodia as they continue to purchase property for new churches; \$50,000 for United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) Global Health ministries to aid the Ebola-ravaged countries of Sierra Leone and Liberia; and \$50,000 to support mission projects working with the poor in the Danville and Eastern Shore districts.

**The June issue of the Virginia United Methodist Advocate will offer a preview of the 2015 Annual** Conference that will be held June 19-21 in The Berglund Center (formerly Roanoke Civic Center) in Roanoke. Worship, election of delegates to General and jurisdictional conferences, celebration of mission and ministry, ordination, resolutions, petitions and other business will all be part of the gathering. The Advocate is the official monthly magazine of the Virginia Conference. As part of a special arrangement with the Virginia Conference, **Kings Dominion amusement park is offering United Methodists discounted prices on tickets during United Methodist Days at the park.** *Cost is \$34 per person for ages 3 and older for discount tickets valid June 25-29, July 1-6, and July 18-20.* Children ages 2 and under will be admitted free. During the discount days, two Christian music events will be held on the park grounds. KingsFest (three full days of Christian music featuring speakers and singers of praise and worship including Skillett, LeCrae, Tenth Avenue North, Jeremy Camp and more) will be June 25-27. JoyFest (one of the country's largest gospel festivals featuring Fred Hammond, Tamela and David Mann and Tye Tribbett) will be Saturday, July 18. KingsFest and JoyFest tickets are sold separately in advance through the call center at (804) 876-5000. Cost is \$40 for Good Any Day tickets, which are valid April 11-Oct. 31. The Virginia Conference will receive \$1 for each ticket purchased online during United Methodist Days.

The conference Board of Church and Society is partnering with American Jews for a Just Peace/Jewish Voice for Peace Boston's Health and Human Rights Project to co-sponsor an Interfaith Peace-BUILDER (IFPB) delegation to **Israel/Palestine Nov. 2-15**. This delegation will participate in the Palestinian olive harvest season — generally a time of great community activism, when people of all ages from Palestine, Israeli peace and justice groups and international groups join farmers as they reap their harvest. Participants will hear from Palestinian farmers and learn of the importance of agriculture to the Palestinian economy and culture. They will also meet Israelis and Palestinians working for peace and justice and Israeli settlers who have a different perspective. While the purpose of the delegation is to learn from Israeli and Palestinian peacemakers, the group will also visit some of the traditional religious sites. Cost will be around \$2500, which includes 13 days of hotel and home-stay accommodations, breakfasts, dinners, local transportation, guides, speaker/event fees, basic tips and gratuities. Scholarships are available. *Cost does not include domestic and international airfare, which will be block-purchased.* For more information on Interfaith Peace-Builders and this delegation, go to [www.ifpb.org/del55/default.html](http://www.ifpb.org/del55/default.html).
