

Dr. Donna Mott and Darlene Runalduo (Korean study led by the Rev. Hyunsik Kang); or issue study on "The Church and People with Disabilities" led by Brenda Connelly. After a spontaneous offering of \$28,560 in cash and \$22,000 in pledges was added to funds raised throughout the previous year and at the "Mulligans Against Malaria" golf tournament and sale of donated artwork, **the Virginia Conference has raised \$916,064.16 for Imagine No Malaria**, saving more than 91,606 lives from the deadly disease. This is just \$83,936 (or 8,394 lives) short of the conference goal of raising \$1 million in order to save 100,000+ lives.

After Annual Conference approved a petition calling for removal of a statement in the United Methodist book of law that calls homosexuality "incompatible with Christian teaching," Bishop Young Jin Cho issued a letter to all Virginia Conference United Methodists. "I want you to know that this vote took place in the midst of honest debate and prayerful discernment. Throughout it all, the expressed will of all participants was that we might know God's will for our church at this time," Bishop Cho wrote. He also admitted that "the results of this action will be received with widely varied responses. But whatever those responses, what has not changed is that we are a people who share a common heritage and a common ministry in Christ Jesus. We are called to live and work together as a family of faith."
